Jennifer Fillmore is the Program Director of Gambling Treatment, Co-Occurring Disorders, and Forensic Projects at the Indiana Division of Mental Health and Addiction. She has over 15 years of experience in addiction counseling and 9 years in program development and coordination. She is a licensed clinical addiction counselor and a member of Indiana Counselor's Association on Alcohol and Drug Abuse (ICAADA), International Certification and Reciprocity Consortium, Indiana Association for Addiction Professionals (IAAP), and the Association of Problem Gambling Service Administrators.

Jerry Bauerkemper is the executive director of the Nebraska Council on Problem Gambling. He has been providing counseling to gambling families since 1986. He has published research on the prevalence of problem gambling in the Nebraska Probation Department, is a nationally recognized expert on problem gambling and has provided training throughout the United States.

Jenny Campbell-Roux is the executive director of the Problem Gambling Network of Ohio. She has treated problem gamblers for five years via inpatient and outpatient and is a LCDCHL, NCGCI. *Pat Bringardner* has been in private practice for seven years and is a NCGCI, SAP, CEAP and is a board member of the PGNO. Together, they have presented several workshops in Ohio in the recent past.
