Other options a short stroll or bus ride away include a lively down-town restaurant, club and music scene; the Portland Art Museum, the Chinese Classical Garden; the Oregon Museum of Science and Industry (great for families), the Pearl arts cultural district; Powell's Books (covering an entire square block with hundreds of thousands of books), the 35-year-old Portland Saturday Market located in Waterfront Park; and nationally recognized music, theater and dance companies

When visitors choose to extend their stay, many tours or trips are within two hours drive of Portland including: the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area; Mt. St. Helens; Evergreen Aviation and Space Museum — home of the Spruce Goose; and everything in between.
