



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, problem gambling is a public health issue affecting Nevadans of all ages, ethnicities and socioeconomic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, problem gambling has a significant impact on individuals, families, businesses and communities across the state; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada has established the Revolving Account for the Prevention and Treatment of Problem Gambling, providing Nevada residents access to affordable treatment services, as well as supporting problem gambling prevention, education and research initiatives; and

WHEREAS, since 1984, the Nevada Council on Problem Gambling has worked with stakeholders to develop sustainable programs and services to reduce the impact of problem gambling, while providing access to information, treatment, and support services through the 24-hour confidential Problem Gamblers Help Line (1-800-522-4700) and WhenTheFunStops.org; and

WHEREAS, addressing and preventing problem gambling is a priority in the Silver State and an important component of Nevada's continued leadership in the global gaming industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEVE SISOLAK, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim March 2019, as
