# The Need for a National Problem Gambling Helpline

An estimated **2 million US adults (1%)** meet the criteria for severe gambling problems in a given year.

Another **4-6 million (2-3%)** meet one or more of the criteria for gambling disorder and are experiencing problems due to their gambling behavior.

NCPG estimates that the annual national social cost of problem gambling is **\$7 billion**. These costs include job loss, bankruptcy, gambling-related healthcare spending and more.





### What is problem gambling?

Problem gambling includes all gambling behavior patterns that have negative effects on an individual. Gambling disorder, which involves repeated, problematic gambling behavior, is a recognized mental health diagnosis.

# Here are some signs of a gambling problem:

- Thinking about gambling all the time.
- After losing, returning to try to win money back ("chasing losses").
- Gambling despite negative consequences.
- Feeling the need to bet more money, more often.
- Feeling restless or irritable when trying to stop or cut down.
